Wait times averaging 48 days vaulted gastroenterology to the third-lengthiest wait times in our study. Gastroenterology is a difficult specialty to access in part because gastroenterologists have a variety of clinical duties in multiple settings: clinic office visits, endoscopy suite procedures, and hospital call coverage are the most common. Because of this, some concerns, while urgent to the patient, end up taking a back seat. Given a significant shortage of gastroenterologists in the US, these challenges are only growing.
